GETTING STARTED:

- 1. What was said in the sermon that got your attention, raised a question or had an impact on your life?
- 2. In one or two words, how would you describe the relationship you had with your brothers or sisters when you were growing up?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 3. What (resentment, judgmental attitude, arrogance, etc.) do you think holds Christians back from victorious living and enjoying fellowship in the church, in marriage and in family?
- 4. What do you need to work on so you can "dive in" and enjoy fellowship with our church family, your spouse or your children? Consider the areas described in *Hebrews 13:1-6*.
- 5. Hebrews 13:17 says that leaders, "keep watch over you." When someone keeps watch over you, what does that mean? How does that imply that God uses church leaders for your protection?
- 6. Read *Hebrews 13:18*. List specific ways your group can pray for the church leaders, and then spend a few minutes praying for them.
- 7. As you surrender to Christ, how does he equip you for life on earth? How can his body (the church) help equip you?

3. <u>Experience His Lordship</u> - (*Hebrews 13:20-22*). Only He can equip us for life on earth.
