

## WHERE WE GO FROM HERE

Use the following notes in your Growth Group or for further personal study of today's message. We hope these will enrich and deepen your walk as you study God's Word.

### GETTING STARTED:

1. Begin by reading *Hebrews 10:19-25*. What stands out to you in this passage and from the sermon regarding where we go from here?
2. Do you agree or disagree that we have simplified Christianity into a self-serving, all-about-me system? Why?

### DIGGING DEEPER

3. Based on Christ's sacrifice (vv. 19-20) and priesthood (v. 21) what attitudes and actions follow? (Note: the "let us" statements in verses 22-25).
4. What does each one mean? What incentives are given?
5. How do verses 19-25 parallel *Hebrews 4:14-16*? Why does the author need to stress this to these readers and to us today?
6. Why is "do not neglect meeting together" in the same sentence as "consider how we can stir one another toward love and good deeds?"

### APPLICATION:

7. In what specific ways can you spur on another Christian toward love and good deeds?
8. How can your group members pray for you this week in light of what you learned from this lesson?

Last week's message from *Hebrews 9:27-28* spoke clearly on three subjects: death is certain, judgment will follow, and the sacrifice of Jesus can save us. Clean, clear and crisp. Now what? Today's passage gives us our very next steps. Once we receive Jesus as our Savior, we then need to stay focused and keep going in these following three ways.

1. **Faith: Cling to God** - (*Hebrews 10:22*). Soak in the fact that all your sin and guilt is cleansed.
2. **Hope: Confident in God** - (*Hebrews 10:23*). What disciplines must you keep to remain steady in God?
3. **Love: Creative in God** - (*Hebrews 10:25-25*). In consideration of others, what creative way can you encourage?
