7. How is it a struggle to allow God to do His job and for you to remain faithful in the tasks He has given you?

8. What is one practical way you can trust God to do His job and remain faithful in the tasks He has given you (*Matthew 6:33*)?

1. **The Person: Baruch** - (*Jeremiah 45*). In the midst of world conflict, He cares for you!
2. **The Complaint: Woe is me** - (*Jeremiah 45:3*). Baruch was clearly discouraged, disheartened and disillusioned.
3. **The answer: Change perspective** - (*Jeremiah 45:4-5*). Trust in the sovereignty of God.
