THE FINAL WORD

12/12 in the series Jeremiah: Wounded Healer

All sad things need to come to an end. The wrap up of Jeremiah's prophecy teaches us some final lessons for tough times. During his faithful 40 years of ministry, Jeremiah successfully obeyed God, made lots of people angry and won over two people with his message (*Baruch and Ebed-melech*). Not exactly a sprint to the finish line like we would all have hoped for. However, the practical applications to his prophecies are timeless. Let's consider our own deepest heartache, and learn some final life lessons from Jeremiah.

1. **Jeremiah** - (*Jeremiah 43:6-7*). Jeremiah disappears from the story, while the land, the temple and the people are conquered.
2. **The people's final lesson** - (*Jeremiah 52:3*). Fighting God in tough times will make things unnecessarily worse.
3. **Unexpected rest** - (*Jeremiah 52:31-34*). God typically meets our needs in unexpected ways.
