# The Gift Chapter

17/20 in the series Great Chapters of the Bible August 2, 2015 • Pastor Robb Williams • 1 Corinthians 12

As a believer in Jesus Christ, we each possess a unique giftedness and are therefore a valuable piece of the body of Christ. Today's great chapter (*1 Corinthians 12*) is the most comprehensive chapter on the subject of spiritual gifts. Following an overview let's all increase our use of our gifts for the benefit of God's mission to reach the world with His love.

1. What in the world are "spiritual gifts"? - (1 Corinthians 12:1-6; 1 Peter 4:10; Romans 12:3-6) Spiritual gifts are the God-given capacity of every Christian to carry out their function in the body of Christ.

2. Why are believers given spiritual gifts? - (1 Corinthians 12:7; 1 Peter 4:10-11) To serve one another and to bring glory to God.

3. **Is there a target, or end game in regard to spiritual giftedness?** - (*Ephesians 4:13*) We work together uniquely to build one another up into the fullness of Christ.
