King of Kings

The book of Revelation is a frightening book to some, confusing to many, and yet it is extremely exciting for the believer in Jesus Christ. There is something wonderfully overwhelming about the thought of Jesus and his flowing robe that will read "King of Kings and Lord of Lords". In this famous "return of Jesus" text, let's finish our series with this amazing chapter, and let's make sure we will be ready.

1. **Jesus will be back** - (*Revelation 19:11-16; Zechariah 14:1-11*). This event is one of the basic and most exciting promises of God.
2. **It is in great contrast to His first coming** - (*Matthew 2:1-5; Revelation 19:11-16*). His return is an exciting promise and is remarkably different than His first coming.
3. **His second coming is both a promise and a warning** - (*Acts 1:6-11; Revelation 19:11-16*). This all amounts to great news or terrifying news. It's up to each of us.
