Use the following notes in your Growth Group or for further personal study of today's message. We hope these will enrich and deepen your walk as you study God's Word.

### GETTING STARTED:

1. What got your attention, made you think or was a new idea in Sunday's sermon?

### DIGGING DEEPER:

2. Do you face any family opposition to or ridicule for your faith? How do you deal with it? How does Jesus' situation help you (*John 7:1-5*)?
3. Are loved or hated by the world (*John 7:7*)? Why?
4. Are you more likely to be cautious in sharing your faith with your family? Why?
5. What different opinions about Christ do you hear today? Why does that confusion exist?
6. Considering the context of water being poured out every day during the feast of tabernacles as a symbol of God's provision, what does *John 7:38-39* mean?
7. What evidence can you offer of the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life? How is His presence like flowing water (*1 Corinthians 4:10*)?

### APPLICATION:

8. How do you need to be refreshed by Jesus? What is one way the refreshment you experience overflows to others?

## A Totally Fulfilled Life

Today's conversation with Jesus is neither solemn nor subtle. Within a perfectly chosen context, Jesus boldly and clearly launched himself forward as the one who brings life's satisfaction. He nourishes, replenishes, fulfills, refreshes and provides life to all who would come to Him. This was the message of Jesus, and it remains our message today.

1. **The context is chuck full of symbolism** - (*Leviticus 23:39-43; John 7:1-36*). To grab hold of today's setting is to grab hold of the significance of Jesus' announcement.
2. **Jesus stood up and cried out** - (*John 7:37-38*). Notice He is addressing "anyone" and "whoever", which includes us.
3. **The most refreshing water you will ever taste** - (*Isaiah 58:11; John 7:37-39*) Jesus not only satisfies you, He satisfies others through you.

Are you fulfilled? Is your fulfillment overflowing to others?
