7. In light of *John 14:6*, how would you respond to someone who said, "There are many ways to God."?

WORK IT OUT:

8. Specifically, how will you put Jesus' teaching into practice so you can live securely?
9. What is He asking you to pay attention to in your life, family, work or future?
10. How can we help each other live securely in Christ?

We just need a place to rest! We have all been betrayed; we have experienced hurt by the closest of friends and family, and we have all experienced loss. We just need a safe place to rest. We long for it, and Jesus alone provides it. In *John 14:1-6*, Jesus addresses the saddest of hearts with the greatest of news. We all hurt, and in Jesus, we can be fully comforted.

1. **Our future is bright** - (*John 14:1-2*). In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?
2. **We are never alone** - (*John 14:3, 18-21*). "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also."
3. **Jesus is our rest** - (*John 14:4-6*) "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."
