Sometimes he was God and other times he was a man.
5. Why is it important that Jesus was (and is) God?
6. What is it about Jesus that most intrigues you and makes you think He is worth following?
7. What is it about Jesus that most makes you want to tell others about Him?
8. What is required to be adopted into God's family?

WORK IT OUT:

9. Based on who Jesus is and what He has done for us, what specifically do you believe you need to surrender or do for Him?
10. How can your Growth Group help or come alongside you in this endeavor?

There is a pretty powerful assertion in *John 1:1-3* in regard to who Jesus is. We may even say it is totally ludicrous, if not for the fact that it is true. These opening verses of the New Testament have some extremely deep implications in theology, but they also have some of the most practical implications. Let's celebrate Jesus as The Word and experience the benefits in everyday life.

1. **Jesus is...** - (*Genesis 1:1; John 1:1-14; John 20:31*). These great introductions have a clear point in mind.
2. **Jesus is the Word** - (*John 1:1-3*). He is an instrument for the execution of God's will.
3. **Jesus is pre-existent, God and Creator** - (*John 1:1-5*). The implications of these verses are incredible.
