7. When facing distressing situations in life, how can we trust God more rather than our own abilities, resources and understanding?
8. What can our church do to significantly touch our community with God's grace?

9. What steps of obedience can you make to impact our community and point people to Jesus?

The reading and studying of these somewhat obscure Bible characters can enrich our lives. This ten week series will explore ten Bible characters who have much to teach us about life. These "Supporting Cast" characters (*with somewhat obscure mentions in the Bible*) carry significant life lessons, and each story individually could mend hearts, change defeated lives and even save lost souls. 1. **Everyone has pain** (2 Kings 5:1). *Everything is just right, but that one great pain screams the loudest.*
2. **Hope comes from the smallest of places** (2 Kings 5:2-4). *We do not ever need to cure anyone, we simply direct them.*
3. **Healing comes from simple obedience** (2 Kings 5:5-14). *The cure was simple, maybe too simple.*
