Consider for a moment what you are known for the most. I'm certain you will be known for many things: your career, your family, your good works or even an indiscretion or two. What would the quick summary be? An even better question is, "what would you like to be known for?" Here is a character forever known as having walked with God. Pretty fantastic! It is never too late to create in our lives that which we most want to be known for, with Enoch as our example.

1. **Enoch who** - (*Genesis 5:21-24; Hebrews 11:5-6; Jude 14-15*)? Enoch was the great, great, great, great son of Adam.
2. **Enoch was a pleaser of God** - (*Hebrews 11:5-6*). ...but without faith, it is impossible to please God...
3. **Enoch walked with God** - (*Genesis 5:21-24*). To "walk with God" signifies a life surrendered, controlled and lived for God.
