

Use the following growth group discussion questions to deepen your relationship with God, his Word and others.

REMEMBER JOHN 14

BREAK IT OUT:

1. What is one of your favorite Bible promises? How has it helped you?
2. What got your attention or surprised you in Sunday's sermon?

TALK IT OUT:

3. What bold promises does Jesus make to comfort His troubled disciples and us?
4. Notice the claim of Jesus in verse 6. Why does this claim make people uncomfortable?
5. How might we share the message found in verse 6 in a way that's humble and faithful to the example Jesus set before us?
6. What remarkable promise about prayer does Jesus make in verses 12-14? How does this promise challenge the way we pray?

WORK IT OUT:

7. What one key promise or take-away from this passage do you need to apply to your life as you think of your life journey?
8. How can your growth group pray for you this week?

The next time you are frustrated with life, or frightened about your new situation, remember *John 14*. In any setting of change, transition or loss or when you experience the unfair nature of life, remember *John 14*. In the most personal of conversations, Jesus spoke of his guaranteed comfort and care. Let's follow the setting and movement of this amazing passage and enjoy the comfort and care of Jesus' words in *John 14*.

1. **Heart troubled? Trust God and Jesus** - (*John 14:1*). More have successfully trusted Jesus than any other life source. Do you?
2. **Restless? You have a home** - (*John 14:2-3*). *Our hearts will not rest until they rest in God* (St. Augustine).
3. **Wandering? He knows the course** - (*John 14:4-6*). Or...he does not know the way, is not the truth, and is not the life. Choose correctly.

Conclusion

Do you "know" Jesus? If you do, you "know" the Father too (*John 3:16, John 14:6-7*).
